Trustee Storm, Committee Chair, said the Committee did not meet since the last regular Board meeting.

Buildings & Site.

Trustee Curtis, Committee Chair, said the Committee did not meet since the last regular Board meeting.

Foundation.

Trustee Wright, Foundation Liaison, highlighted the following information and said this was provided by Ms. Christina Donsbach, Executive Director for College Advancement:

- The Foundation is excited to be hosting the first Community Partners Breakfast on Jan. 23 which will launch the Community Partners Program for 2025. So far, we have 13 businesses committed to date, raising over \$67,000. The program is a sponsorship opportunity where businesses engage with campus, students and events throughout the year.
- Financial Aid, Student Life and the Foundation offices are teaming up Jan. 22-23 for the Subs & Scholarships event to let students know about Foundation Scholarships and assist with questions. The 2024-2025 Foundation scholarship application closes for the first cycle January 31. The 2nd cycle will reopen the month of August.
- The Foundation is hosting our 5th annual Love A Laker Giving Day on February 14. We will seek one-time donations from employees, board members, alumni and community members on this day.

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Student Report

Ms. Abbie Kelly, Student Trustee, offered a few highlights from the Student Government Association's accomplishments last semester. The SGA hosted a successful Red Cross Blood Drive, assisted with the Special Olympics Family Festival, organized several fun and engaging events while fielding student suggestions to enhance campus life, and ended the semester teaming up with the Lake Land College Student Activity Board and The Navigator News hosting a Toy Drive benefiting the One Stop Community Christmas. The SGA collaborated with the Collegiate Farm Bureau, Ag Transfer Club & the Broadcasting Club to raise nearly \$700. Ms. Kelly said the new Navigator News is out. The SGA had a mid-semester selection to bring on 4 new students. She also said the student life scholarships were awarded to 20 students, each student receiving between \$100 to \$500.

President's Report.

Dr. Bullock gave the following updates:

- The College received no payments in December from the Illinois Department of Corrections or from the Illinois Department of Juvenile Justice (IDJJ) for the FY 2025 outstanding balance. A balance of \$1.3 million remains outstanding with IDOC and \$62,095 with IDJJ.
- In December, the College received payments from the State of Illinois for FY 2025 credit hour reimbursement of \$352,776 and equalization of \$574,383. A balance of \$2.9 million in credit hour reimbursement and \$3.4 million in equalization remains outstanding.
- The College received \$6,337 in property tax payments in December.

Business - Non-action Items.

Quarterly Investment Report.

Mr. Joseph Fearday, financial advisor with SC3F Wealth Management (formerly Wells Fargo), presented the Quarterly Investment Report for the period ending December 31, 2024.

Updated Report on the Guided Pathways Strategic Enrollment Management Plan.

Ms. Pam Hartke, Associate Dean of Recruitment and Enrollment Management, highlighted progress being made with the Guided Pathways Strategic Enrollment Management Plan. Trustee Reynolds commended the work of the group and their accomplishments and Chairman Cadwell praised their commitment to recruitment efforts.

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Monthly Data Point Discussion – State and Federal Funds Supporting Our Students.

Dr. Lynn Breer, Director of Institutional Research and Reporting, highlighted two reports featuring state and federal funding that supports and directly impacts our students.

Update on College's Aspirational Goals for the Illinois Business Enterprise Program.

Mr. Dylan Cole, Assistant Comptroller & Purchasing Coordinator, presented on the College's progress in meeting the aspirational goals set by the Illinois Business Enterprise Program which was created in 1989 to increase the amount of State procurement dollars towards majority-owned businesses by women, minorities, persons with disabilities and veterans. The report also detailed how Lake Land's progress toward meeting the current aspirational goal of 30% aligns with all other community colleges in the state.

Update on Disposition of Surplus Items or Equipment since January 2024.

Mr. John Woodruff, Vice President for Business Services and Treasurer, summarized the dispensation of surplus items or equipment since January 2024. He said Ms. Madge Shoot, Comptroller, reported that several items were dispensed of via an auction, netting \$54,360.87 for the College after Bauer Auction Services fees. Mr. Woodruff also said some items were donated or transferred to other community partners or used as trade in value for new equipment purchases. Trustee Storm asked if there was any value to selling the turbine. Trustees learned the College paid \$7,046 to Grunloh Construction Inc. of Effingham to take down and remove the decommissioned wind turbine.

Proposed Revisions to Board Policy 07.28.02 – Academic Integrity Code.

Dr. Ike Nwosu, Vice President for Academic Services, highlighted a request from Ms. Sarah Hill, Director of Library Services, on behalf of the Academic Services Artificial Intelligence (AI) Task Force, for the Board to approve proposed revisions to Board Policy 07.28.02 – Academic Integrity Code.

Proposed revisions were submitted as first reading, and the administration will plan to bring this recommendation back to the Board of Trustees for approval during the February 2025 regular meeting.

Trustee Lilly commented that he believes the College has a duty to help students appropriately learn how to use AI, and that he hopes our faculty embrace AI for the teaching and learning opportunities that it presents. He said he would like to see the proposed revisions to this Policy

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be updated to reflect those teaching and learning opportunities and that the proposed language change not just be punitive in nature. Trustees Walk and Reynolds concurred.

Calendar of Events.

Trustees reviewed a calendar of upcoming events. Additionally, Dr. Bullock reminded the Board about the special Board meeting on April 14, 2025, at 4:00 p.m., a special board meeting on April 24, 2025, to conduct the annual organization meeting and hold a retreat for strategic discussions and effective board governance training. Dr. Bullock also reminded Trustees about the May 16, 2025, Commencement.

Action Items.

Approval of Annual Schedule of Board of Trustees Meetings.

Trustees reviewed the proposed schedule of regular Board meetings to be held in 2025. Ms. Jean Anne Highland, Chief of Staff, recommended that the Board approve the 2025 schedule of Board of Trustees meetings and said that regular Board meetings have traditionally been held on the second Monday of each month. Ms. Highland said that is what we are recommending for all months in 2025 except for August 2025. For this month, she said the administration is recommending holding the regular monthly meeting on the third Monday due to anticipated timing requirements for presenting the FY 2026 budget at the July 2025 meeting and waiting at least 30 days to approve the budget at the August 2025 meeting.

Trustee Walk moved and Trustee Curtis seconded to approve as presented the 2025 Schedule of Board of Trustees Meetings.

Acceptance of November 2024 Financial Statements.

Trustees reviewed the November 2024 Financial Statements and a memorandum from Mr. Woodruff that highlighted the Financial Statements and significant variances. Mr. Woodruff said some of the significant variances are timing related and should normalize by year's end.

Trustee Curtis moved and Trustee Storm seconded to approve as presented the November 2024 Financial Statements.

Approval of Faculty Seniority Listing.

Trustees heard a request from Dr. Ike Nwosu, Vice President for Academic Services, for the Board to approve the Faculty Seniority Listing effective January 13, 2025. He said that Chapter 22 of the Illinois Revised Statutes, paragraph 103B-5, requires each community college district to establish a faculty seniority list no later than February 1 of each year and that this list must then be distributed to appropriate employee representatives. He also said Division Chairs and administrators have reviewed the list and believe it is in compliance with the Act.

Trustee Reynolds moved and Trustee Lilly seconded to approve as presented the Faculty Seniority Listing effective January 13, 2025.

Approval of Resolution No. 0125-016 to Transfer Funds to the Designated Insurance Fund Balance.

Mr. Woodruff said that, per the request of the College's auditor, the College has established a designated insurance fund balance to record excess and shortfalls in our insurance spent throughout the year. He requested the Board approve the above-referenced Resolution and that by doing so the Treasurer will be authorized to transfer insurance funds between Fund 01 - Education Fund and the designated insurance fund balance to remunerate expenditures.

Trustee Curtis moved and Trustee Walk seconded to approve as presented Resolution No. 0125-016 to transfer funds to the designated insurance fund balance. [A full and complete copy of the Resolution is attached to and part of these minutes.]

Acceptance of John Ullrich Foundation Grant Award.

Trustees heard a recommendation from Dr. Nwosu that the Board accept grant funds from the John Ullrich Foundation. Trustees learned the grant funds will be used to provide individual scholarships to support students majoring in agriculture who are from Coles, Douglas, Macon, Piatt, and Moultrie counties. Dr. Nwosu said grant funds will also be used to support a variety of instructional supplies and materials for the Agriculture Division, including, but not limited to, replacement hand tools for student boxes, a drone camera, a hydraulic flow meter, and a tissue sampler.

Dr. Nwosu said dollar amounts have been removed to comply with the Foundation's confidentiality guidelines and that the authority to issue a press release on this award rests solely with the John Ullrich Foundation.

Trustee Wright moved and Trustee Reynolds seconded to accept as presented the John Ullrich Foundation grant award for FY2025.

Approval of Maintenance Agreement for Liquidware.

Mr. Woodruff presented a recommendation from Mr. David Stewart, Chief Information Officer, for the Board to approve a two-year renewal maintenance agreement with Liquidware Labs, Inc. of Alpharetta, Georgia, at a total amount of \$68,110 or \$34,055 per year, for streamlined software setups, applications and enhanced cybersecurity. Trustees received the detailed quote from Liquidware Labs for the proposed service timeframe of March 6, 2025 through March 6, 2027.

Mr. Woodruff said that these services and supplies are exempt from bidding requirements per the Illinois Public Community College Act 110 ILCS 805/3-27.1 or Board Policy 10.22 (#4. F.).

Trustee Walk moved and Trustee Curtis seconded to approve as presented a two-year renewal maintenance agreement with Liquidware Labs, Inc. of Alpharetta, Georgia, at a total amount of \$68,110 or \$34,055 per year, for the period March 6, 2025 through March 6, 2027.

Dr. Bullock said the administration submitted proposed revisions to this policy as first reading during the December 2024 regular meeting, and the administration now respectfully requests Board approval during the January 2025 regular Board meeting. He said that since presenting this as first reading in December 2024, the administration has not received any additional feedback or requested modifications.

Trustee Wright moved and Trustee Curtis seconded to approve as presented proposed revisions to Board Policy 05.04.09 – *Leave for Jury Duty or Court Attendance*.

Waive First Reading and Approve Proposed Revisions to Board Policies 06.24 – Attendance in the Classroom and 07.39 – Student Call to Military Duty.

Dr. Ike Nwosu requested the Board waive first reading and approve proposed revisions to the two above-referenced Policies. Trustees received the details of the proposed revisions. Dr. Nwosu reported that these revisions are needed in order for the College to be in compliance with legislation - HB 5655 - National Guard/Reserve Classwork, now Public Act 103-0871, effective January 1, 2025.

Dr. Nwosu said this new law requires that the governing board of each public institution of higher education adopt a policy to allow a student who is a member of the National Guard to

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submit classwork and complete any other class assignments missed due to the student participating in a drill or other military obligation required as a member of the National Guard or the reserve component. He said the policy revisions address this new law and allow the two Policies to operate congruently.

Trustee Reynolds moved and Trustee Lilly seconded to approve as presented proposed revisions to Board Policies 06.24 – *Attendance in the Classroom* and 07.39 – *Student Call to Military Duty.*

Please find below a summary of December actual results to the approved budget. We have now completed the first six months so we are 50% through the 2025 fiscal year. At this time there are no results/budgetary areas of concern and no indication, that I'm aware of, that would create cause for concern in the near future as we progress in FY25.

December - Noteworthy Events Impacting Results

- Excess Revenue over Expenditures –We finished December unfavorable at \$460,493.
- Revenue Revenue for December was unfavorable by \$972K. The second property tax payment from Effingham County was recognized in November versus December as budgeted. –
- Expenditures Expenditures for December finished favorable by \$512K. YTD we are \$3.543M favorable to budget. Mid-year this is a good position to be in but given the potential uncertainty around Federal legislation/direction, it is imperative we remain financially focused the second half of this fiscal year.

Funds – Noteworthy Events – YTD

- Fund 3 Fund 3 now contains the proceeds of \$4.6M related to the debt certificate proceeds as a result of the completed bond process. We did recognize ~\$1M in ETC construction spend. Total expenditures are running behind anticipated budget. With both levels of ETC in construction, will recognize increased spend over the next three months.
- Fund 5 Fund 5 is favorable to budget by \$639K.

RE:	Adult Education Tuition Waivers Request

Lake Land College is deeply committed to providing accessible education and opportunities for all individuals, regardless of their background or prior educational experience. In line with this mission, our Adult Education Programs have seen notable enrollment growth across our High School Equivalency (HSE) and English Language Acquisition (ELA) courses.

In FY 21, enrollment in these programs stood at 33 ELA and 189 students HSE students, with 36 graduates. By FY 24, this number had risen significantly, with 199 students enrolled in ELA and 228 in HSE, resulting in 101 graduates. Currently, for FY 25, our enrollment remains strong, with 179 ELA and 136 HSE students and 27 graduates thus far.

While our programs are accessible, we recognize that even with low tuition costs, financial barriers can still prevent students from advancing into higher education. To address this, we propose a three-credit-hour tuition waiver to assist students as they transition to further academic pursuits, enhancing their chances of success. We request that this tuition waiver be implemented beginning with the Summer Term 2025 and continue for three years, ending in the Spring Term 2028.

At the current tuition rate of \$113.50 per credit hour, the three-credit-hour waiver would amount to \$340.50 per student. Students would still be responsible for all associated fees. We anticipate offering 25-40 waivers annually, resulting in an estimated total benefit ranging from \$8,512.50 to \$13,620.00 over the duration of the program.

Therefore, I respectfully request that the Board approve a three-credit-hour tuition waiver for all GED graduates and English Language Acquisition students who meet the necessary skill level required for college coursework.

Recommended Motion:

Any High School Equivalency student who completes all Illinois High School Diploma requirements or any English Language Acquisition student meeting the skill level required for college coursework will be eligible for one three-credit-hour tuition waiver during the semester following their completion or mastery of skills.

During the FY2025 fiscal year, our Technology Division was awarded the Rev Up EV Round 3 grant through ICCB. In order to move forward with grant activities and goals, the automotive technology program would like to purchase equipment, curriculum and instructor training from Legacy EV. Legacy EV is the sole provider of specialized electric vehicle (EV) educational tools, including proprietary instructional aids and curriculum exclusively designed to enhance automotive training programs at academic institutions.

The automotive technology program is requesting to purchase a variety of equipment, curriculum and instructor training including, but not limited to: 3 registrations for EV Fundamentals Certification Bootcamp training for instructors for \$15,000, 2 Top Kart MSTEM3 electric go karts for \$23,000, 2 user accounts for Introduction to E-Mobility Curriculum for \$9,000, 1 EV Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) bundle for \$2,284.16, 2 100V EV Training Test Benches for \$70,000, 2 user accounts for EV Tech Curriculum for \$28,000, 1 EV Tech Premium PPE & Safety Equipment Bundle for \$2,180, and 1 EV Tech Premium Wire & Tooling Bundle for \$3,850. Shipping for the Top Kart MSTEM3 electric go karts is \$1,750. Shipping for the 100 EV Training Test Benches is approximately \$3,000. The Rev Up EV Round 3 grant has \$158,064.16 for the purchase of these items.

Since Legacy EV is the only provider that produces and offers this equipment, curriculum and instructor training, the bidding process will not be necessary to purchase these items. I have also included the sole source letter from Legacy EV. I respectfully request your approval to issue payment to Legacy EV for these grant items.

TRUST AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into by and between the Lake Land College whose address is_5001 Lake Land Boulevard, Mattoon, IL 61938_hereinafter called the Using Educational Agency, and a Bank First Mid Bank and Trust whose address is 1515 Charleston Avenue, Mattoon, IL 61938 hereinafter called Bank.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS the USING EDUCATIONAL AGENCY is required by law to pay a contribution to that certain project, known as Capital Development Board project number *CDB* project # (810-058-034), in the amount of six hundred thousand dollars; and

WHEREAS, the USING EDUCATIONAL AGENCY may elect to deposit the contribution under a Trust Agreement, with an Illinois Bank of the Using Educational Agency's choice, pursuant to 71 Illinois Administrative Code 30.110, as amended October 1, 1984.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties do hereby agree:

1. That the USING EDUCATIONAL AGENCY does simultaneously with execution hereof deposit with Bank funds totaling six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000).

2. That the funds so deposited with the Bank shall be described as the "contribution" and shall be held by the Bank in trust according to the terms of this agreement.

3. That the USING EDUCATIONAL AGENCY shall receive any interest thereon.

4. That earnings on the trust corpus shall be paid by the BANK to the USING EDUCATIONAL AGENCY not less frequently than quarterly.

5. That the Executive Director (in his or her official capacity) or the Administrator of Fiscal Management (in his or her official capacity) of the Capital Development Board are the only persons authorized to direct the BANK to make payment out of the trust, other than payment of earnings to the USING EDUCATIONAL AGENCY in accordance with Section 4 hereof.

6. The right of the Executive Director or the Administrator of Fiscal Management of the Capital Development Board to direct payment is restricted in that any such funds so directed shall be made payable only to: "The Order of State Treasurer of Illinois, Capital Development Board, Contributory Trust Fund".

That the BANK shall pay such funds within two (2) working days upon the receipt of the written direction of the Executive Director or the Administrator of Fiscal Management of the Capital Development Board, and that any agreement between the BANK and the USING EDUCATIONAL AGENCY, shall, in no way, affect the duty of the BANK to so pay upon demand.

8. That the BANK, as Trustee, shall invest in securities of the type utilized to collateralize deposits by the Treasurer of the State of Illinois, or time deposits, open accounts, certificates of deposit, savings accounts or enter into a re-purchase agreement; however, all time deposits, open accounts, certificates of deposit, savings accounts shall be covered by a pledge of securities to cover the difference between the FDIC insurance and the total unsecured amount (of the type listed in Paragraph 2, below) on deposit with the depositor bank of the Trustee Bank. A "safekeeping receipt" for such deposits shall be submitted to the USING EDUCATIONAL AGENCY covering the securities pledged, and a certified statement to the effect that all monies invested have been adequately protected, shall be submitted to CDB by the BANK. Should the re-purchase agreement cover securities other than those listed in Paragraph 2 of this Section, such agreements shall also be subject to the pledge of securities provision as described in this Section. The term "securities of the type utilized to collateralize deposits by the Treasurer of the State of Illinois" means: direct obligations of the United States Government; general obligations of the State of Illinois; notes, bonds, debentures or participation certificates of the Federal Mortgage Association, Federal Intermediate Credit Bank, Federal Home Loan Bank, Federal Land Bank, Illinois Building Authority, Illinois Toll Highway Commission of Illinois State Toll Highway Authority; Public Housing Authority Notes; obligations of the Export-Import Bank of Washington, D.C.; general obligations municipal bonds (including school districts) within the State of Illinois rated "A" or better by Moodys; and Farmers Home Administration Insured Notes provided such notes are quoted and are non-amortized.

9. That the USING EDUCATIONAL AGENCY shall be responsible for obtaining the written execution of the Trust Agreement by the BANK. Any costs or service fees of the BANK shall be borne by the USING EDUCATIONAL AGENCY.

10. That when the total amount of the contribution has been paid from the account in accordance with the directions of the Executive Director or the Administrator of Fiscal Management of the Capital Development Board, this Agreement shall be terminated and any accumulated interest or earnings thereon shall be paid over to the Using Educational Agency.

RE:	Task Force Recommendations for Spring 2025

The Lake Land College Academic Services AI Task Force is proactively addressing the challenges and opportunities presented by AI. Through policy development, resource creation, and open dialogue, we aim to create an environment that fosters the ethical and practical use of AI for teaching and learning.

After the initial draft of the policy was presented to the Cabinet, the Board, and the campus community, a revision was made to enhance the College's future-oriented focus. The task force recommends that the following change be made to Board Policy 07.28.02 Academic Integrity Code.

07.28.02

Academic Integrity Code

Lake Land College is committed to the fundamental values of preserving academic integrity as defined in this policy. It is assumed that students will honor the tradition of academic honesty. Promoting and protecting academic honesty and integrity are the responsibility of every member of the College community. As such, students have the responsibility to:

- 1. Be fully knowledgeable of the Academic Integrity Code;
- 2. Produce their own work; and
- 3. Encourage academic honesty among their fellow students.

Academic dishonesty is a serious offense that is investigated and sanctioned through Board Policy 07.28.01, Student Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedures.

Acts of academic dishonesty include but are not limited to:

1. Cheating: Using or attempting to use unauthorized materials, information, or study aids in any academic exercise.

As such, no student shall, during the course of a graded academic exercise, (1) offer information of any kind to another student; (2) receive information of any kind from another student or from the responses made by another student; or (3) have in their possession any tool, written material, or other device which may be of assistance to them in completing the exercise and which has not been authorized by the instructor or person proctoring the academic exercise. No student shall procure, possess, or provide in any unauthorized manner any materials or pieces of materials which contain the questions or answers to any graded academic exercise scheduled to be given to any individual or group enrolled in any course of study by the College. No student shall submit the same assignment in more than one class without instructor approval. Inappropriate use of artificial intelligence (AI) can be deemed as cheating. The use of generative or agentic AI tools to produce or assist in the completion of academic work, unless explicitly authorized by the instructor, is prohibited.

2. Plagiarism: Representing the words or ideas of another as one's own in any academic exercise.

As such: No student shall submit as their own material to an instructor any work which contains ideas or materials taken from another without full acknowledgment of the author and the source including appropriate citations and documentation. This includes submitting a paper, or portions of a paper, obtained from a professional service or, website, AI, or written by another individual.

- 3. Fabrication: Falsification of information or citation of an academic exercise. No student shall seek credit for a group assignment in which they did not participate or claim that an assignment was submitted when it was not. No student shall fabricate sources or misrepresent secondary sources within a paper.
- Unauthorized Collaboration: Sharing or working together in an academic exercise without approval.
 No student shall work with another student to complete a graded assignment without prior approval from the course instructor. Work completed through authorized collaboration must clearly identify the contributions of each individual.
- 5. Facilitating Academic Dishonesty: Helping or attempting to help another student to violate any provision of this Code.

Use of Artificial Intelligence (AI)

At Lake Land College, we recognize the increasing use of artificial intelligence in different fields and everyday applications. While we encourage the use of AI, we expect compliance with this policy on the ethical use of this evolving technology.

- 1. Students must adhere to the instructor's policies (found in the course syllabus) on using Al-generated content in their work.
- 2. Students must check any AI content for accuracy and bias. Students are responsible for the integrity of all AI-generated content used.
- 3. Students must not use AI to cheat or plagiarize by submitting AI-generated content as original work.

Procedures Following Academic Dishonesty

1. The instructor who has witnessed academic dishonesty or who has evidence that academic dishonesty has occurred will contact the student to inform the student of the allegation and the instructor's intended actions.

- 2. The instructor may assign the student a reduced or failing grade on the assignment or in the course. The instructor will submit an Academic Integrity Incident Report to the Vice President for Student Services describing the incident and the intended actions.
- 3. Additional disciplinary sanctions may be imposed in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedures.

(See Policy 07.28.01.) The student will be provided written notification of the charges and actions to be taken and be given ten (10) calendar days to notify the Vice President for Student Services if the student wishes to dispute the charges.

- 4. If a student disputes the allegation of academic dishonesty, a hearing will be provided according to the Student Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedures.
- 5. A student accused of academic dishonesty in a course may not drop the course until such time as disciplinary action, if any, is imposed. If a grade of "W" is recorded for the course, it may be changed to reflect the disciplinary sanctions imposed as a result of academic dishonesty. In the event that the alleged violation occurs at the end of a term, an incomplete grade shall be assigned pending conclusion of the disciplinary process.

Lake Land College may contract with an electronic service to detect originality of materials submitted by students. By registering for courses offered by Lake Land College, students consent that all assignments are subject to submission for textual originality reviewed by an electronic service. Assignments submitted to an electronic service source may be included in the service's restricted database solely for the purpose of detecting plagiarism.

The total furniture cost proposed and summarized is not to exceed \$336,285.48 detailed as follows:

- \$280,158.33 This includes the furniture for all classrooms, common areas and offices on the second floor as part of the phase 2 ETC build-out. The furniture will match current Lake Land color specifications and classroom mobility requirements and would allow repurposing in any Lake Land location. The new furniture will fill the gap between what was left from Patterson and the needs of the new areas/rooms. Ordering the furniture at this time will keep us on schedule for the July 30th open house.
- \$56,127.15 This furniture replacement/upgrade is in conjunction with the remodel of the Northwest Labs scheduled to start in May following commencement and conclude July 31st. This will provide the Fall semester and future students with a first-class education experience in chemistry classroom/labs in definite need of remodel/upgrade.

The College is utilizing Widmer Interiors who is a member of the Omnia contract pricing associated with state bidding which alleviates the need to seek bids on the above-related furniture purchase.





- 1. <u>Pricing</u>: Prices quoted are valid for 30 days unless otherwise specified. Prices quoted may not include applicable sales tax. All orders are subject to approval by our credit department.
- 2. Deposit: A 50% deposit is requested prior to order entry.
- 3. <u>Installation</u>: Customer shall provide adequate facilities for off-loading, staging, moving, and handling of furniture. Unless otherwise noted on the proposal, elevator availability and use is assumed when product is to be installed anywhere besides the ground level. Stair carry will incur additional cost when not noted at time of quoting. Unless otherwise noted, delivery and installation will be made during normal business hours and based on non-prevailing wage labor. Additional costs will apply for overtime or additional work requested by the customer. Risk of loss transfers to the customer once the product is on site.
- 4. <u>Installation Delays</u>: If job site is not ready for furniture on the agreed scheduled installation date, additional charges may apply for extra handling and warehouse storage fees. Widmer will make every effort to minimize additional charges in the event of a delay. In the event of a delay, the merchandise will be considered accepted by the customer for purposes of payment. The customer may withhold the installation amount of the invoice against completion of delivery.
- 5. <u>Returns</u>: All product is made to order; therefore, all sales are final. All requests for changes in quantity or specification shall be in writing and if approved, additional charges may apply.
- 6. <u>Direct Shipping Product</u>: When the customer receives a direct shipment of product, it is the customer's responsibility to inspect the merchandise at time of receipt and file any freight claims within the manufacturer's required timeframe. While Widmer will assist as much as possible, Widmer cannot be held responsible for freight damage when product is shipping directly to the customer.
- 7. Payment Terms: Terms are net 15 days from date of invoice. A service charge of 2% per month will be added to all delinquent invoices. Customer shall not withhold payment in excess of the selling price of the specific merchandise that has not been delivered or is subject to repair and/or replacement.
- 8. <u>Payment Method</u>: Pricing is based on payment in cash, check or ACH. A 3% convenience fee will be added to invoice if a credit card (American Express, Visa or Mastercard) is used for purchases over \$2,500. Credit cards will be charged in full at time of order.








CHEMISTRY LAB/LECTURE 108 SCALE: 1/2" = 1'-0"
