

\$1,000 SCHOLARSHIP

The Crawford County Farm Bureau Board of Directors annually presents **at least** one \$1,000 (one-thousand dollar) scholarship to a qualified applicant. **Reapplication is encouraged.** The recipient is selected by the Scholarship Committee and the Board of Directors, based on the consideration of all completed applications submitted. The decision of the committee is final. The award will be presented to the successful applicant at a time and place to be determined by the committee.

All applicants must:

- Be a farm bureau member, member's child or grandchild, in good standing of the Crawford County Farm Bureau
- Be a high school senior or current college student intending to our currently pursuing a degree related to agriculture at an accredited community college, college, or university. I.e., Diesel mechanics, livestock/animal science, nursing with a focus on rural health
- Provide appropriate verification of current class rank and cumulative GPA
- Provide one letter of reference from a teacher, guidance counselor, principal, or other school official
- Provide one letter of reference from a non-school related person as evidence of good character (may not be written by an immediate family member)
- Complete and return the application form and essay by the deadline
